



## *Arts Martial*

In honour of our new Queen, a series of combats as follows will be held –

### *The Art of Defence – Saturday 7pm*

A tournament held according to 16<sup>th</sup> Century Belgian rules.

The combatants will have one hour to vie for the honour of holding the field.

Cut & thrust weapons are encouraged as well as standard rapier.

*Those who have been Royal consorts are encouraged to meet with the King & Queen at this time to enjoy the fine display, and discuss matters pertaining to their order.*

### *Armoured Combat – Sunday 11am*

A Rose tournament will be held to coincide with the Arts & Sciences discussions on Sunday morning. All are encouraged to challenge others to combat for the honour of a lady.

In the traditional Lochac style, the victor of each challenge shall deem the recipient of a Rose from the hand of the Queen and her Ladies, to be presented by the defeated.





## *Things you need to Know:*

### *Climate.*

The weather in Canberra at this time of year is usually in the low-mid 30 degree range. As the weather has been unseasonal at the moment, you should plan for the possibility of rain also.

### *Dress*

Most locals plan outfits with layering. Protection against both the sun, and possible rain would be advisable. At the same time, as the event is entirely outdoors and in parkland. As such parts of site are steep, uneven or prone to mud. Please make sure you are wearing appropriate footwear.

### *Sunscreen and hats*

Most people are careful about direct sunlight, but please be aware both our sites are by the water. The glare from the lake can lead to sunburn. While there is some shade in the form of trees and provided sunshades, the event is taking place outdoors in summer.

### *Bring Non alcoholic drinks*

It is likely to be hot, and as both sites are on the lake, it can also tend to be windy. Some cordials will be provided, but you are advised to bring your own non-alcoholic drinks to avoid heatstroke.

### *Concerns for those bringing Children*




